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Why We Fast and Pray

The LORD said to me, "See, I have begun to deliver Sihon and his country over to you. Now begin to conquer and possess his land" Deuteronomy 2:31

1. We need to fast and pray for our marriage because we are a prime target of the enemy. If you desire to step into your purpose in life you have to be prepared to fight for it. The battle for your purpose and significance is both physical and spiritual because the spiritual world controls our physical world. What happens to us in the physical world is actually what has already happened to us in the spiritual realm.

Fasting and prayers are effective because:

1. It allows you to fight on both ends [the spiritual and the physical] of the battle at the same time.
2. It is the weapon of choice against stubborn spirits. "However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting." Matthew 17:21

3. Fasting is a simple process that anyone can be involved in anywhere in the world. It does not require special tools and/or special people. You do not have to be a pastor, priest or a prophet to fast.
4. We have many accounts in the bible where fasting helped people to win the battles of life.
5. Fasting actually brings us closer to God and farther away from the worldly distractions.

2. We need to fast and pray because the journey to our purpose is a process, and we need grace to succeed. There is a period of conception, incubation/gestation, contention, and delivery before we can fully possess the promises of God. Each of this process is fraught with dangers and challenges. The word “possess” means to control completely, to use as you like and to be in charge. Even after you have taken possession of your promise you still have to be alert because there are forces determined to limit your control, interfere with your usage, and challenge your position. Spiritual warfare is your weapon of choice

to contain those forces and fasting elevates you above the enemy.

3. We need to fast and pray because the battles of life are inevitable and multifaceted. It is naïve to be ignorant of these situations. Please understand that the greater your purpose, the fiercer your battles will be. Secondly, the height of your assignment in life determines the strength of the obstacles you must go through to complete your assignment. For some of us the battle started from our birth like Jacob, Jesus Christ, and Moses.

These battles are from the same source but manifest in different shapes and forms – delayed birth, deformity as a child, troubled childhood, difficulty getting married, difficulty staying married, misconnection with strange men and strange women or failed marriage – so we see it manifest in different areas of our life- getting married, staying marriage, conceiving children, raising children, health, wealth, etc.

4 Facts About The Enemy

- The devil has already decided to fight you. Whether you like it or not the devil is ready for a fight. The scripture teaches us that, “In this world you shall have tribulations but be of good cheer for I have overcome the world.” John 16:33.
- The devil does not excuse you because you are holy or blameless. In fact the holier you are, the more intense the battle for your life and destiny. The man Job was blameless before God but he had to fight for his life.
- The devil does not excuse you because you are spiritually powerful. The more aware you are of the activities of the devil, the more likely you are to engage him instead of ignoring him.
- The devil does not excuse you because he likes you. The only favorites the devil has are those in his hell fire. Even those who are in his camp wish they were not, so ultimately the devil has no favorites. He comes only to steal, kill and destroy your destiny.

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may

have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly. John 10:10

And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force. Matthew 11:12

4. We fast and pray because it is the most effective weapon for the battle. The first law of warfare is to know yourself and the resources available to you in the battlefield. This means that you must practically count your weapons, know their reach and how and when to use each weapon. A farmer may have a machete and a shovel, but he has to know when to use them. He cannot use a shovel to cut or use a machete to dig. Accordingly, a Christian has to be aware of his authority as a believer, the power in the word and the power in the blood of our Lord Jesus Christ.

“And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and

they did not love their lives to the death.

Revelation 12:11.

Fasting and prayers allows us to use all the weapons of warfare. We can pray, read the bible, meditate on the word, and plead the blood of Jesus Christ at the same time.

5. Fasting and Prayers helps us to be conscious of the enemy and his strategy. The second law of warfare is to know your enemy. Understanding who you are up against will help you hone your strategy for battle. There is a saying that you don't go to a gun fight with a jack knife.

"For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*". Ephesians 6:12

Different Kinds of Fast

Fasting is abstaining from food for a spiritual purpose. Fasting is more effective when it is accompanied by prayers and studying the word of God. Note that fasting without a spiritual purpose is dieting. This devotional is designed as a guide for fasting and prayers both for married couples and those who are Single for now. Although the book is best used as a guide for 21 days fasting period, it may also be used as a daily devotional for specific prayer needs as the topics depict.

The three most common kinds of fast are:
Absolute fast, Normal fast and Partial fast.

1. Absolute Fast. An absolute fast is when you abstain from food, water, and other pleasures for a period of time. This fast should only be done with a doctor's supervision. This type of fast requires discipline, careful planning, and execution. The good thing is

that it is extremely rewarding for those who dare to engage in it.

2. Normal Fast. Normal fast is the fast whereby you may allow yourself to only drink water for a time certain. Some of the popular durations of normal fasts are: 6 am -12 pm, 6am – 6 pm, 6 am -6am next day (24 hours), 3 days fast, 7 days fast, 14 days fast and 21 days fast. It is important to remember that the idea of fasting is to discipline your body and soul to seek God.

3. Partial Fast. Partial fast is giving up something in exchange for seeking God's face. You may do it in different ways like abstaining from certain food for a period of time. Daniel fast is a typical example of partial fast. This devotional will guide you in whatever type of fast you choose to do. May the Lord grant you the desires of your heart.

Guidelines to a Successful Fast

It is always advisable to talk to your doctor before engaging in any period of fast especially if you are elderly, pregnant or on medication. There is need for proper preparation before a protracted fast. Your preparation must therefore focus on preparing your body and preparing your spirit to connect with God.

The best way to prepare your spirit is to start shutting down your normal life activities a few days before the period of fasting and praying. The next thing to do is to consecrate your mind to the purpose of the fasting and praying.

Wrong Assumptions About Fasting: Many people assume that the most difficult part of praying and fasting is abstaining from food. Nothing can be farther from the truth. In practice, when you are fasting and praying, the desire for food will decrease after the first few hours for a day fast and the first few days for long fasting periods. It is advisable to

prepare for long fast by watching what you eat and reducing the quantity of food you consume a few days before the fasting period. This will make it easier for you to ease into the program.

How to Enhance Your Effectiveness: The hardest thing to do during fasting and praying is to be absorbed, immersed, and completely focused on Him. You can be more effective during this period by removing anything that may distract you from focusing on your purpose. Clear your public and personal calendar. Keep your activities to the barest minimum, only doing what you must do like going to work, going to church, and taking care of your children. Shut down from social media and your social circles if possible. Another way and perhaps the most effective way to consecrate yourself is to go away to a quiet and secluded place.

9 Things to Do During Fasting and Prayers

1. You Must Confess and ask For Forgiveness of your Sins. Sin and unforgiveness of sin can stop you from receiving your breakthrough. Confess every sin and avoid sinning like a plague especially during this period of fasting and prayers. Psalm 66:18, John 9:31

2. You Must Do Something Good. You must do something good during the period of fasting and prayers for something better to happen to you. God does not come down from heaven to help people. He uses people to help people. Isaiah 58:5b-9 gave us a clue into what will secure God's attention, "Is this what you call fasting? Do you really think this will please the LORD? "No, this is the kind of fasting I want: Free those who are wrongly imprisoned; lighten the burden of those who work for you. Let the oppressed go free and remove the chains that bind people. Share your food with the hungry and give shelter to the homeless. Give clothes to those who need them, and do not hide from relatives who need

your help. “Then your salvation will come like the dawn, and your wounds will quickly heal. Your godliness will lead you forward, and the glory of the LORD will protect you from behind. Then when you call, the LORD will answer. Yes, I am here,’ he will quickly reply.”

3. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you during a period of fast. The purpose of fasting and prayers is to sanctify and separate yourself in order to secure the presence of God. The Holy Spirit is the only person who can lead you into the presence of the almighty God. 2 Chronicles 14:11

4. Set your eyes of expectation on the Lord. Start your fasting and prayers by setting expectations. Have a list of things you desire from God. Without expectation you won't even know when and if your prayers are answers. Remember, you are about to go unto the mountain where prayers are answered. Psalms 123:1-3; Psalms 145:15; Psalms 126:1-2; Psalms 136:25; Psalms 104:27.

5. Ask God for revelations and instructions.

Revelation and instruction are the gateways to your promotion. The blind Bartimaeus asked to receive his sight first. When he received his sight, he followed Jesus. Solomon asked for wisdom first and when he received his wisdom, he wrote the Proverbs and Ecclesiastes. Paul prayed for the Corinthians that their eyes of understanding may be opened.

6. Ask God to increase your faith and confidence in Him.

Faith is the only currency we can use to purchase God's miracles. The amount of faith you have will determine how much you can purchase during this period of fasting and prayers. Luke 17:5, Mark 9:23

7. Ask for His favor on you and your household.

Favor qualifies you to receive what you are otherwise not qualified to receive. You need a dose of uncommon favor for uncommon breakthroughs. Psalms 106:4.

8. Ask for Restoration and Recovery. You cannot move forward until you have been restored to your former position. In the same way you cannot increase what you have until you have recovered what was lost, stolen or damaged. Restoration and recovery is the starting point of growth and increase 2 Kings 8:5-6, Matthew 9:22.

9. Ask God for the completion of all things. Completion is the mark of wholeness and wholeness is evidence of God's hand in your life. It is not richness but prosperity. It is not fullness but fulfillment. It is not happiness but extraordinary joy. It is not peace but perfect peace. Philippians 1:6

DAY 1

OUR DAY OF VISIONS

Focus Scripture: Genesis 15:5 “Then the LORD took Abram outside and said to him, “Look up into the sky and count the stars if you can. That’s how many descendants you will have!” (NLT)

Additional Scriptures: Genesis 35:1-15, Joshua 1:1-9. Isaiah 6:1-1-2, Genesis 32:23-32, Luke 18:1-8, Matthew 11:12.

Meditate

The word “vision” means the ability to see things that are invisible to others with clarity. A visionary is a person who can see the invisible with enough clarity to convert the invisible thing visible and real to others. God creates things by seeing the things first,

and then commanding those things to come into existence. Genesis 1:1-28. There are two ways to express the power of vision. Romans 4:17.

Seeing possibilities in the impossible, Life in the dead.

The bible says that God sees life in things that are dead with enough clarity to make those dead things come alive. Luke 1:34, John 3:4, Genesis 18:12.

Seeing Things that no man can see with clarity. The bible says that God calls things which are not even in existence into existence. Romance 4:17.

There are two kinds of visionaries. Those who see and create, and those who hear and obey.

The first kind of visionaries are creators – They see something where others see nothing, say something, believe that thing and keep saying it and believing it until what they are seeing becomes visible to others. 1 Kings 18:41-46, Jeremiah 1:13.

The second kind of visionaries are uncompromising followers of God. They hear something from God and follow the instruction to the letter. Abraham is a good example. He did not see what God was seeing but he followed where God was leading. Genesis 12:1-4.

We will follow this template closely in this year of abundance. Vision provides essence, direction, motivation, matrix, and a sense of accomplishment. Whether you and /or your family desire to make the impossible possible, or to call into an existence thing that be not, this year of abundance is full of possibilities. There is nothing the LORD cannot do.

10. Let us pray against small strength in 2023.

Proverbs 24:10, Jeremiah 51:46.

DAY 2

DAY OF CONSECRATION

Focus Scripture: I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. Romans 12:1

Additional Scriptures: Exodus 19:22, Psalms 51:1-17, Joshua 3:5, Joshua 5:2-15, Joshua 7:13

Meditate

The word consecration has the same meaning as sanctification. It means to set aside for a purpose. God demands our undivided attention and undistracted focus. Exodus 20:3-5. "Thou shall have no other gods before me" (KJV). There are three kinds of people that God does not work with are 1. unrepentant sinners, 2.

Idolators, 3. unbroken spirits and a person who is not willing to seek God with all his/her heart and mind.

Isaiah 59:2, Exodus 20:3-5 and Revelation 3:16.

There are five steps to effective consecration.

1. Taking an inventory of your current life and identify where you need improvement in your relationship with God. This means taking inventory of your life to see where we may not have prioritized God or compromised his principles.
2. Remove those from your mind, body and spirit things which does not honor God glory. This includes unforgiveness, hatred, resentment, lustful thinking, revenge. Colossians 3:5
3. Rededicate everything you have to God. This means mind, body, soul, time, talent, and treasure to Kingdom business.
4. Maintain your commitment to live your life for God.

5. Periodically review and repeat steps 1, 2 and 3.

DAY 3

DAY OF PRAISE AND WORSHIP

Focus Scripture: Teach me Your way, Oh LORD; I will walk in Your truth; Unite my heart Your heart name. I will praise You, Oh Lord my God, with all my heart. And I will glorify your name. I will praise You, Oh Lord my God, with all my heart. And I will glorify your name forevermore. Psalms 86:11-12.

Additional Scriptures: Psalms 100:4, Psalms 65, Psalms 48:1-3, Psalms 50:23, Psalms 66:13-15.

Meditate

Praise is a weapon of spiritual warfare that will guarantee victory in this year of abundance. Our God uses different strategies for to confront and confuse the enemy. For example, to create things God spoke

to them into existence, to confront the devil Jesus rebuked him, but in warfare God has consistently used praise and worship to overwhelm the enemy. Acts 16:25-26 and 2 Chronicles 20:22. God ordains strength with words Psalms 8:2, and Psalms 149:5-9. In this year of Abundance, we will praise our God for our sufficiency, more than enough and abundance.

Prayer Focus:

1. Let us welcome the Holy Spirit in our midst Romans 8:26; Let us offer our sacrifices of praise and worship to our God Psalms 100:4; and let us open our mouths and confess our sins. Psalms 66:18, Romans 10:10 and Isaiah 1:18.

3. Sing a song of praise unto the LORD. Psalms 149:1-4
4. Let us praise God for words. Psalms 148:5

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5. Let us praise Him for His faithfulness Psalms 148:6, Psalms 119:90-91, Psalms 93:1
6. Let us praise Him for His loving Kindness
7. Let us remember His awesome power
8. Let us not forget His mercies that endures forever.
9. Let us sing a song of praise for 2023.

DAY 4

DAY OF POWER AND EMPOWERMENT

Focus Scripture: For everyone born of God is victorious and overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has conquered and overcome the world — our [continuing, persistent] faith [in Jesus the Son of God]. 1 John 5:4 AMP

Additional Scriptures: Deuteronomy 8: 18, Psalms 44:3, Luke 10:19, Proverbs 18:21, Isaiah 40:28-31,

Meditate

To live a life of abundance in 2023 we need to connect with the source of power for abundance. God gave Joshua extra ordinary powers to help him actualize

the vision of taking the children of Israel to the promised land. God made Joshua invincible and indestructible. "No man shall be able to stand before you, all the days of your life..." Joshua 1:5.

To be victorious, power must change hands, principalities must be displaced, and stronghold demolished. Luke 10:18-19 says "18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you."

Spiritual powers can only change hands through spiritual warfare. Matthew 11:12, "And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force." And in Luke 11:21-22 the scriptures states that "21 When a strong man, fully armed, guards his own palace, his goods are in peace. 22 But when a stronger than he comes upon him and overcomes him, he takes from

him all his armor in which he trusted and divides his spoils.”

Friends, today we pray for power for Abundance in 2022. You will exercise your divine power over stubborn and persistent problems in your life. Let the fun begin.

1. Let us start by inviting the Holy Spirit who intercedes for us with groanings that cannot be uttered. Roman 8:26
2. Let us confess our sins before the almighty. 1 John 1:8
3. Let us sing a new song of praise unto the Lord. Praise is the key to life of abundance Psalms 96:1
4. Father, help me to always know who I am in you. Psalms 119:18, Phil 3:10-14

5. Father, give me the wisdom to know the enemies and the angels. Ephesians 6:12
6. Father, let my fear overwhelm my adversaries and drive them away. Deuteronomy 2:25
7. Let us bind the devil and his agents in the name of Jesus Christ. Luke 11:21-22
8. Command the release of your promises and your prophecies.
9. Pray against the prince of this world withholding the answers to your prayers.
Daniel 10:12-13

DAY 5

DAY OF SPIRITUAL WARFARE

Focus Scripture: Put on the full armor of God, so that you can make your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against rulers, against authorities, against the powers of this darkness, and against spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realm. Therefore take up the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you will be able to stand your ground, and having done everything, to stand Ephesians 6:11-13.

Additional Scriptures: 2 Corinthians 10:3-6, 2 Corinthians 11:14, Psalms 18:35-48, Romans 13:12, Isaiah 54:14

Meditate

Now that we have been empowered, we need to be aware of the authority (exousia) given to us to use the power (Dunamis) in the word of God to wreak havoc in the kingdom of darkness. God said to Joshua, no man shall be able to stand before you, all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so will I be with you. I will not leave you or forsake you” Joshua 1:5.

What then is Spiritual warfare: Spiritual warfare is:

1. You must be born again.
2. You must know the word. 2 Timothy 2:15,
Luke 11:21
3. You must understand the power of the enemy,
Ephesians 6:12.
4. You must understand your authority as a
believer over the devil Luke 9:1
5. You must know how to use your authority to
advance God’s purpose in your life. Mark 4:39-
40.

To be effective in spiritual warfare, you must know when to rise, rebuke the devil, speak to the problems and not be afraid and have faith. Mark 4:39-41.

Now rise and begin to engage the enemy.

Prayer Focus

spiritual enemies. Psalms 144:1.
3. Thank God for sitting us in heavenly places in
Christ, far above principality, power, power,
might and dominion. Ephesian 1:3
4. Thank God for the authority to tread upon
spiritual serpents and scorpions. Luke 10:19

5. Now we take up the shield of faith to quench every fiery dart of the enemy. Eph 6:16.
6. Let us pray for the grace to engage the enemy.
Luke 11:21
7. Pray to the Lord to give us spiritual eyes that see opportunities, ears that hear divine instructions, and minds that perceive for abundance. Genesis 18:2
8. Begin to break off any spiritual limitation and laziness in your life. Deut. 28:7
9. Now rebuke the spirit of deceit and distractions in your life. John 10:10
10. Let's begin to declare victory over the enemy for our abundance. Luke 10:18

DAY 6

DAY OF DIVINE DIRECTION

Focus Scripture: "I will lead the blind by a way they do not know, In paths they do not know I will guide them. I will make darkness into light before them and rugged places into plains. These are the things I will do, And I will not leave them undone" Isaiah 42:16

Additional Scriptures: Daniel 2:28, Ephesians 1:17, Deuteronomy 29:29, Psalms 119:18, Isaiah 30:21

Meditate

A sheep is not the smartest animal in the world. In fact, pound for pound sheep is the least intelligent but one of the most obedient animals in the world. Jesus wants us to be like sheep to following divine direction. The fear of God is the beginning of wisdom. Jesus Christ compared us to a sheep not because we

are not intelligent but because of the sheep's other attribute –absolute dependence on the shepherd for protection, provision, and guidance.

Fortunately for us Jesus Christ is our Shepherd, and He is the Good Shepherd that is willing to die for His sheep. Friend, whether you survive, thrive or excel in life depends on your connectivity to your Shepherd.

When do you need divine direction? You need divine direction every day especially under the following circumstances:

1. Before you start planning. You need divine direction before you even start planning anything.

Proverbs 16:1 says, “We can make our own plans, but the LORD gives the right answer”

2. While you are planning. You must seek divine direction during the planning phase of your project.

There is a way that appears to be right, but in the end, it leads to death. Proverbs 14:2.

3. When you are executing your plan. You need divine direction when you are executing your plan. Commit your works to the LORD And your plans will be established Proverbs 16:3

Prayer Focus:

1. Praise God for His awesome power. Colossians 1:16
2. Thank God for His divine guidance in 2023. Isaiah 45:2
3. Ask God to anoint your ears to hear His instructions to you loud and clear. Isaiah 30:21
4. Ask Him for wisdom to understand His instructions and divine direction. Exodus 33:13-14.
5. Ask the Lord to give you the special grace to follow His divine directions as a sheep follows its shepherd. John 10:27,28.
6. Pray against limiting God by relying on your own strength instead of riding on His wings.

7. Pray against every suggestion of the enemy that is against the plan of God. Isaiah 30:15,16
8. Banish, remove, and disassociate yourself from anyone that will give you a contrary instruction. Genesis 3:1,2.
9. Celebrate the defeat of Satan and his cohorts in 2023. Luke 10:17,18.
10. Thank God for the BOLD EXPLOITS that God will do through you and your family the remainder of 2023 Jeremiah 51:20-22

DAY 7

DAY OF ABUNDANCE

Focus Scripture: Then he got into one of the boats, which was Simon's and asked him to put out a little from the land. And he sat down and thought the multitudes from the boat Luke 5:3

Additional Scriptures: Exodus 4:2, 2 Kings 4:2, Matthew 6:33, Luke 18:22, Ephesians 4:11-12.

Meditate

In Luke Chapter 5: 1-11, we read the story of a fisherman who had toiled all night and caught nothing. This is a metaphor for using all his skills and strength and failing. We also learn about the 7 principles of attracting and activating your

abundance through good work and for good work.

Here are the 7 keys to note:

1. Your personal abundance is tied to your service and usefulness to the kingdom of God. Kingdom harvest is plentiful but those to activate the abundance laborers are few.
2. God has giving you gifts(boats) that will activate your abundance when you use it for the Kingdom.
3. Many boats are lying dormant because their owners are tired, defeated, distracted, frustrated, ignorant and held in captivity by the enemy.
4. God is asking us to put out a little from the land. Invest your dormant gifts, talent, skills, money in Kingdom work.
5. You must keep your eyes and ears open for his timing and terms i.e instruction. Cast your NETS in the deep. See big, think big, dream big and take big steps. Do not limit yourself by thinking about your past failures.

6. Keep in mind that the opportunity may come in the same place where you failed, or from the same people who disappointed you.
7. Your abundance will impact your family, friends, and the world. Luke 5:7-9

On this day of abundance, what do you have in your hands? Is your boat laying empty? Are you seeking the kingdom of God and his righteousness first, second or last? The key to a life of abundance is to use what you have for good work, and you will hear him say, "Launch out into the deep and let down your NETS for a catch of abundance." Then your abundance will astonish the world.

Prayer Points

DAY 8

DAY OF ABUNDANCE FOR MARIAGES

Focus Scripture: Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor. Ecclesiastes 4:9

Additional Scriptures: Ecclesiastes 9:9, Genesis 2:25, Matthew 19:5, Proverbs 5:18, Deuteronomy 24:5,

Meditate

Marriage makes us good. God built a heaven on earth and handed it over to Adam and his wife to enjoy and live in dominion. God is still in the business of building a heaven on earth for husband and wife in Christ Jesus. Genesis 2:18; Ecclesiastes 4:9; Genesis 1:27-28.

The word bliss is the only thing that comes close to describing God's original idea for marriage. Here are three definitions of the word bliss.

1. Extreme happiness, ecstasy.
2. The ecstasy of salvation, spiritual joy, perfect happiness, serene joy
3. Wikipedia defines bliss as a stage which is above emotional state that is characterized as peace or happiness. (Feeling of enjoyment, pleasure and satisfaction)

Other words for bliss are "heaven", "heavenly", "paradise" and "supreme happiness". Marriage is supposed to simulate heaven because when marriage was established man was supposed to live in the Garden forever. God established man and woman and prepared the Garden of Eden for them to live in bliss, extreme happiness, serene joy and ecstasy. Marriage was established before the blessings of Genesis 1:27 and 28 because the word said, "And He

blessed them". If you are married this should give you bliss, extreme happiness and serene joy. If you are single this is why you must say, 'Father, change my situation.' If you are physically or emotionally separated from your spouse, this is the reason to fight for your marriage. If you are married but not enjoying this level of dominion and ecstasy victory is your portion.

Today we claim abundant life for the never been married and the previously married.

Child of God, please note that God’s vision plan is different from Harvard School of Business model. In Harvard’s business plan you SOURCE for funding. In God’s kingdom plan, you SEE the provision because the provision is provided and limitless before the vision is cast. In God’s plan faith is the currency that we need to SEE the provision. God is not a frivolous father that gives us a vision without giving us a provision.

I remember the first time I did an extended fasting as a young Christian. It was 1985, my sophomore year in college. I decided to fast for three days which meant abstaining from food and drink for the entire three days. On the third day of the fast I was laying on the floor of my apartment, tired and weak when the Lord spoke to me about so many

things most of which has since happened in my life.

That same afternoon I saw my dad in my dream. He visited me in my apartment. I was still in a trancelike state when someone knocked on my door. I slowly dragged myself up from the floor as I heard the knock again, this time louder and harder than before. When I opened the door, my dad was standing there looking at me and muttering something in our local language. He must have thought that I was still very sleepy because he gave me an envelope containing some money, apologized for waking me up and left.

I shut the door and laid down again still in that state. It was hours later when I fully woke up that I was able to separate the dream from the reality. Only the envelope and the money in it convinced me that my father actually came to my room that day.

It was also in that three-day fasting period that the Lord confirmed that my wife is His choice for me and told me many things that has been happening during our 33 years of marriage. God has promised that He will help us on the journey of life.

“Behold I send an Angel before you to keep you in the way and bring you into the place which I have prepared” Exodus 23:20

As you fast and pray, watch out because the Lord will show you things concerning your present situation and your future, things concerning the super abundant year He has in store for you. Be alert so you don't miss any of His revelations. You are well positioned to hear God, see God, and touch God.

In 2 Kings 7:1 the Lord said "About this time tomorrow 24 cups of the best flour will sell for half an ounce of silver in the gateway to Samaria. And 48 cups of barley will sell for half an ounce of silver." It was so!!!

Beloved what problem do you have that is practically and politically impossible to do and you need divine speed on it? I do not know how God will do it, but I know He will answer you speedily. Divine speed is yours as you wait on him.

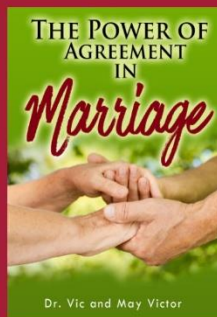
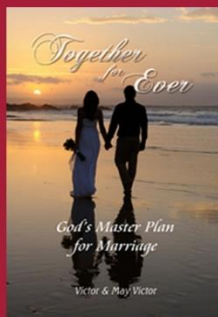
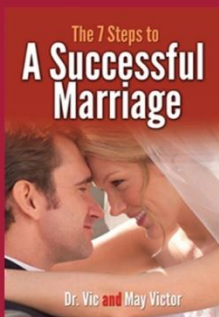
